GLOBAL HIGHLIGHTS

Operation Blessing's multinational staff, including trained engineers, medical professionals, and regional leaders, tirelessly implemented programs and operations in **36 countries** and responded to **39 disasters**.



TEXAS: The Smokehouse Creek Fire burned nearly 1.3 million acres in Texas. You quickly responded with food, water, hygiene kits, and hope for the people of Texas.



COSTA RICA: You blessed approximately 65 children at Palmera School with a rainwater harvesting system, so their education would not be disrupted due to lack of water.



NIGERIA: Thanks to you, we provided much-needed food and medical care after insurgents attacked Christians living in the Bokokos community.



CHILE: Friends like you helped rebuild homes for families who lost everything in the wake of devastating wildfires.



UKRAINE/POLAND: Our warehouse in Poland has sent more than 150 truckloads of food and supplies to the Ukrainian people since the war began. Thank you for supporting these precious people in their time of need.



JORDAN: With your support, we provided medical services for thousands of refugees in Jordan through Mercy Clinic and our ministry partner, Zarqa Baptist Church.



MOZAMBIQUE: Thanks to the love and care of our generous family, 260 people living at a displaced persons camp in Maringanha now have access to clean water.



THAILAND: Your love helped Pitipath and his wife, Hunna, set up a mushroom farm and gain financial independence.



TAIWAN: After a magnitude 6.5 earthquake struck Taiwan, you helped replace home water tanks that had been severely damaged. Now, families have access to clean water again.



GUAM: Thank you for rushing food and providing relief to thousands who were impacted by Super Typhoon Mawar, the strongest storm to hit Guam since 2002.

US DISASTER RELIEF HIGHLIGHTS

RESTORING HOPE WHEN ALL HOPE IS LOST

This year, we have experienced an unprecedented season of disasters here in the United States. From wildfires in Texas, Louisiana, and Hawaii to severe thunderstorms that devastated communities across the Southeast and Midwest with massive flooding and tornadoes, our team has quickly responded to provide relief to those in dire need. The victims of these disasters felt your love in very tangible ways.

After Hurricane Idalia slammed into the west coast of Florida last fall, Linda returned to find two feet of standing water in her home. She didn't know where to begin, until the kindness of strangers came to her rescue. "Operation Blessing knocked on my door and immediately got a crew in here," she told us. "Without them, I really don't know what I would have done."

Then in January, a winter storm system unleashed several tornadoes across the Southeast. In Cottonwood, Alabama, one of the hardest-hit towns, the wind destroyed Lottie's shed and toppled a tree onto her car. All she could do was turn to God. Then our compassionate volunteers showed up and helped her clean up the debris. One even found a treasure. "One of the Operation Blessing men found my Bible ... and I knew everything was going to be okay."

And when the Smokehouse Creek Fire destroyed nearly 1.3 million acres in the Texas panhandle, many ranchers were forced to leave their homes behind. "When I got to the gate, my entrance was on fire. So, I just had to keep going," said Shannon, a local rancher. But you sent hope in the form of rakes and wheelbarrows and other supplies to help them begin the cleanup process.

Thanks to the generosity of friends like you, Operation Blessing is able to respond quickly when disaster strikes and give hope to those who need it most.

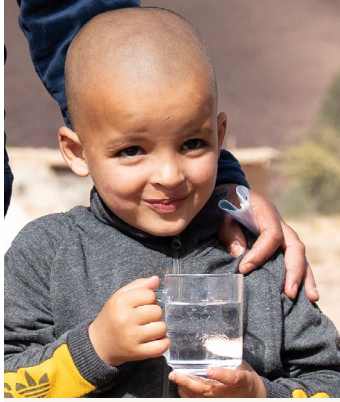

INTERNATIONAL DISASTER RELIEF HIGHLIGHTS

HELPING MOROCCANS CLIMB OUT OF THE RUBBLE

In September, a powerful magnitude 6.8 earthquake shook western Morocco, crumbling buildings and livelihoods. More than 2,000 people died, and hundreds of thousands were left to pick up the pieces of their lives.

Oumaima (age 14) had settled into bed when the shaking began. Plates and glasses shattered on the floor. Even the walls groaned. Oumaima escaped with her family, but their home was completely destroyed. Their remote village, Ait Said, was one of many that had no access to food, water, basic hygiene supplies, or medical care after the quake.

But thanks to your love and support, relief was on the way! Our team supplied more than 4,800 food bags and installed 40 bathroom units for 270 families. Diego Traverso, Director of International Disaster Relief, said “Bringing hope and aid to everyone, regardless of their faith, was truly special.”

Oumaima’s family was grateful for your special care in their time of need. They told us, “Without this generosity, we would have died of hunger.”

Families like Oumaima’s had no way to prepare for the disaster that they faced, but you stood by them and so many others in their time of need.

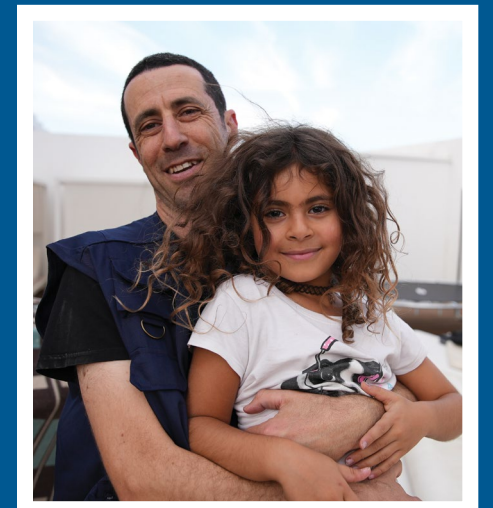

CLEAN WATER

Clean water is something we often take for granted—if we have it. But for the 2 billion people who don't have access to it, the daily struggle to collect water consumes time, energy, and resources that could be spent at school or working.



For many remote communities, water is only available from rivers or old wells that are contaminated with bacteria. It's dirty and tastes bad. Plus, running water is also necessary for proper hygienic practices like washing hands. Lack of clean water and proper sanitation can lead to a variety of illnesses which can be deadly, especially for children and the elderly.

But thanks to your care and concern, many of these communities have found freedom from their struggle with water, because you have provided alternative solutions through through new clean water systems. Most projects included training in our WASH (Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene) program so residents can stay healthy for years to come.

CLEAN WATER

GIVING A FRESH DRINK OF CLEAN WATER



For far too long, Laingeso struggled to find clean water to keep her three children and her livestock alive. Along with the other 430 families living in the remote Korr Villages, the arid land in Kenya didn't offer them much to drink. And over the past few years, severe drought dried up what few watering holes they had, forcing Laingeso to travel by foot to gather water from an old well in Tubcha, the nearest community.

"It would often take me a whole day to get the water," Laingeso told us. The water was salty and caused urinary problems, but it was all they had. Laingeso kept praying that God would provide for a better future for her children and their families.

Thanks to friends like you, that future is now possible. This past year, our generous donors provided the residents of the Korr Villages with a deep borehole well of their own—equipped with multiple faucets, a large storage tank, and a chlorination system that would ensure their water would be clean enough for their children to drink.

Friends like you also blessed these families with bathrooms and hand-washing stations. Our WASH team provided training to educate residents about safe sanitation practices and how these could prevent water-borne disease and help them live healthier lives.

Laingeso thanked God for sending people like you to help! She was excited about how clean water would change their future. "The water was fresh, clean, and very satisfying," she said. "Now we fetch water from the taps and go to the bathroom and shower comfortably."

Clean water and sanitation stations do so much more than give women like Laingeso and their families a fresh drink of water. It also gives them the dignity of privacy—for the very first time in their lives. Thank you for blessing the Korr villages and so many others with clean water.

Zine had experienced hard times. After moving to the US from South Africa 20 years ago, her heart broke from seeing people struggling with mental disabilities around her. She wanted to help, so Zine gave up a well-paying job as a delivery specialist to set up a group home in Virginia to meet the needs of these individuals. She had no idea a global pandemic was right around the corner.

Before starting her new endeavor, Zine set up a strong financial plan, but delays during COVID-19 slowed her down and depleted her savings. When money got tight, she turned to the food pantry at an Operation Blessing partner ministry, Bethel Worship Center Church International.

There, Zine found your love and support. Instead of worrying about groceries, she could focus on those in need. “I can devote my day to working in the business. It just gives me a lot of peace.”

You got her through that tough time. Today, she is working toward becoming more financially independent and no longer needs the assistance of the food pantry. She can focus fully on caring for the needs of others, thanks to you!

HEALTH & MEDICAL CARE

Healthcare is a luxury that people living in poor, remote communities around the world cannot afford. With no medical clinic nearby, they often have to travel long distances—sometimes on foot, by donkey or via boat—to reach the closest facility, costing them valuable time tending to their farms. And if they are able to reach a healthcare facility, they often can't afford the cost of care. Many are left to simply suffer, alone and without viable care.

But they don't have to. Your partnership allows us to take much-needed medical care to villages with the greatest need. Our mobile medical clinics include doctors, dentists, and pediatricians who can help entire families get free treatment and preventative care like ultrasounds, vaccinations, medicines, cancer screenings, vision exams, and dental checkups.

With your help, we also train local men and women to offer basic medical care for their neighbors. These Community Health Volunteers are equipped to check vital signs like blood pressure and detect more serious warning signs that need a doctor's attention. They also provide much-needed health education and encourage disease-prevention habits.

And our Life-Changing Surgeries program is available for adults and children who suffer from crippling medical conditions that could easily be fixed through surgery. We connect these hurting people to compassionate friends like YOU who want to help. Together, we can offer healing free of charge for those in need.

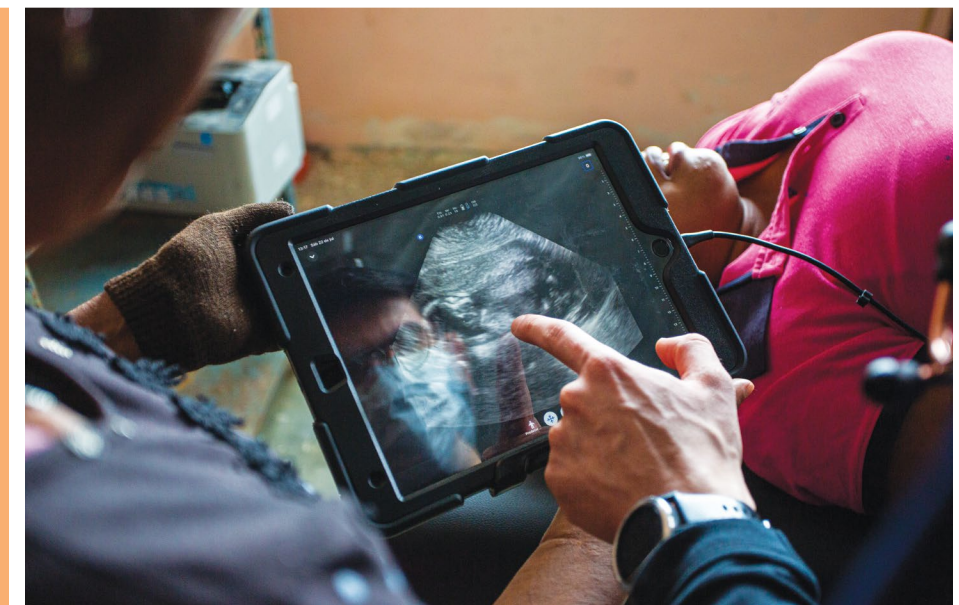

GIVING WOMEN IN PERU THE GIFT OF HEALTH

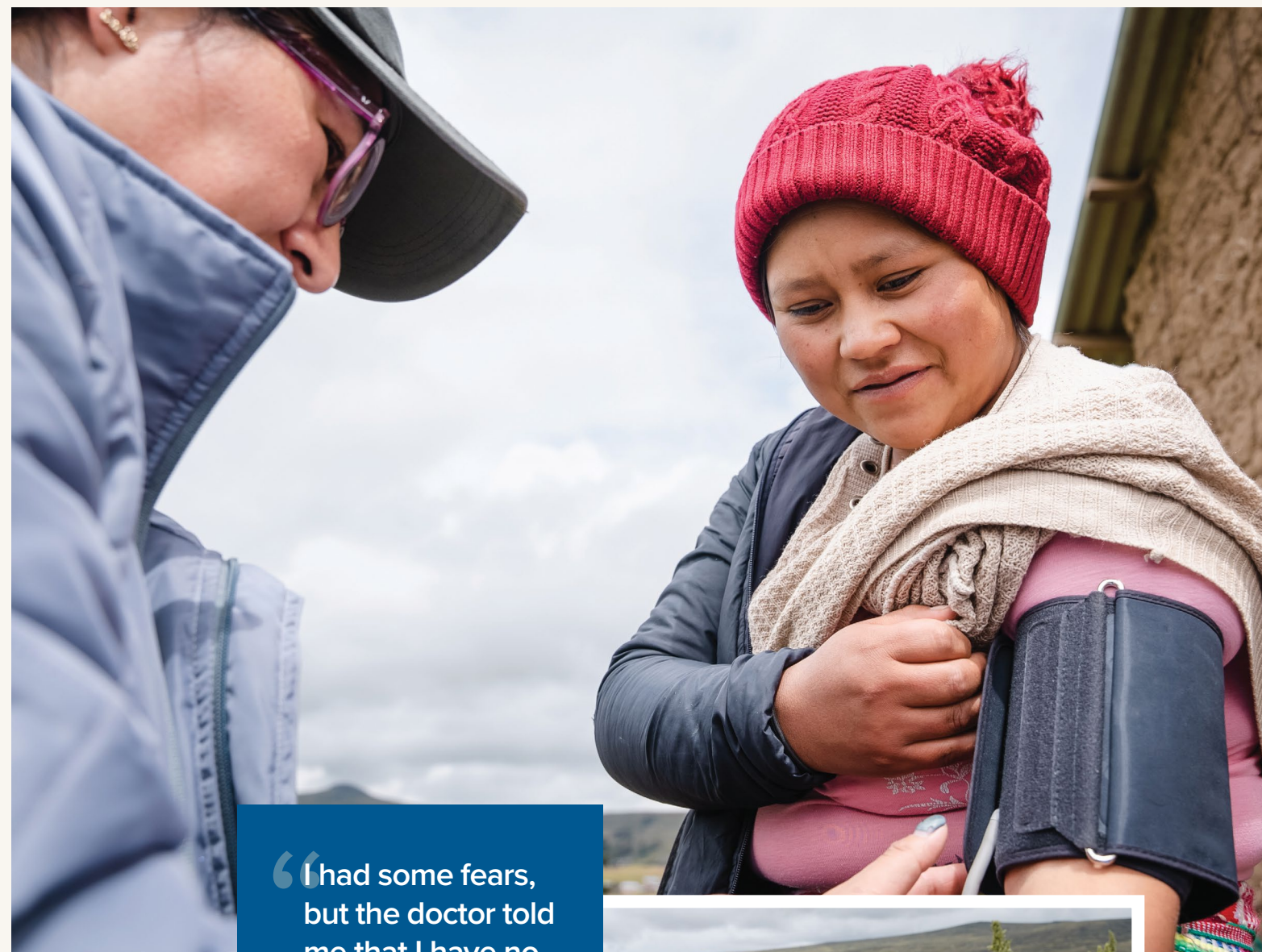
Delfina felt that something wasn't quite right, but she ignored her symptoms. She loved living in the scenic highlands of Peru with her husband and two children, Estefano (age 11) and Maria (age 4), but their remote location created difficulties for the poor farmers. Women like Delfina had to travel more than an hour to reach the nearest healthcare center in Puno. And too often, they could not afford the cost of regular checkups.

But with your support, Operation Blessing was able to take a mobile medical clinic to these remote communities and provide cervical cancer prevention workshops and prenatal counseling for women free of charge.

For Delfina, your love was a relief. "I came because I wanted a checkup with the obstetrician," she told us. "I want to know how I am, because sometimes I don't feel very well."

During the workshop, she received a pap test and learned that she had an infection—but it was treatable. The doctor gave her medication, free of charge. "I am happy and at peace for the attention received. Thank you very much for this support."

Your compassionate care is freeing women like Delfina from the worry they carry and giving them piece of mind so they can focus on caring for their families. Thank you for providing healthcare and educational workshops to empower these precious women to live healthier, happier lives.

LIFE-CHANGING SURGERIES TO RUN WITHOUT PAIN

Every day, Sonam wished she could run free along with her friends. But this sweet 12-year-old girl in India couldn't even walk without pain. Born with severe clubfoot, her ankle was so twisted that her foot was flipped upside down.

Sonam attended a boarding school for students who were physically challenged, but she continued to dream of a brighter future—where she could be a teacher. She had little hope of her dreams coming true.

Early on, Sonam's father tried to help his daughter. He took her to the hospital, but what he learned broke his heart. The method to correct her foot involved five stages of treatment and was very expensive—more than his meager income as a farmer could handle. "I am helpless," he cried. "I am afraid for her future and the pain she goes through."

Thankfully, when compassionate friends like you heard Sonam's story, they rushed to help and provided the funds for the multiple surgeries that Sonam would need to walk—and even run! The process was difficult and painful at times, but Sonam never stopped smiling.

Today, this sweet girl can stand tall, with both of her feet positioned correctly. As her ankles grow stronger, her hope of becoming a teacher strengthens with each passing day. And her parents are thankful for loving people across the globe who gave their daughter a chance to achieve her dreams.

Sonam's mother told us, "I thank Operation Blessing for the kind help and support for my daughter's surgeries."
